Student selected will be invited to our annual awards luncheon at the Crest Hollow Country Club in Woodbury at which time a presentation ceremony will take place. This year our luncheon will be on Friday, June 5, 2020. School personnel are encouraged to attend.

The criteria for nominations are:

- Student must have been in a special program for 60% or more of the school day for significant portions of his/her educational career and will meet the requirements for completion and will exit the district in June of 2020.
- Student must have qualified for the NYSAA
- Student must have successfully met goals on his/her IEP
- Student must have demonstrated good citizenship
- Student should have demonstrated involvement in extra-curricular activities
- Student should have demonstrated evidence of community involvement
- Student's future plans and transition should demonstrate they are deserving of this award
- Student must be exiting the District in June of 2020
